

BSN Early Career Researcher Travel Grant Rules

Eligibility

Postgraduate students and post-doctoral research fellows within 10 years of gaining their PhD. You must have been a member of the BSN for at least 6 months (join here <u>http://www.neuroendo.org.uk/Join.aspx</u>).

Activities the Fund will support

- Strictly for attendance at UK BSN meetings.
- Can be used for travel and/or accommodation
- You should be personally presenting your work at the conference and show proof of registration for the conference with your application.

Award value

Awards will normally be up to a maximum of £150 for UK members and up to £400 for non-UK based members.

Application form and deadlines

Apply via the MySociety portal on the BSN website <u>neuroendo.org.uk</u> Please supply a breakdown of anticipated costs.

For all applicants a letter is required from your supervisor/grant holder as appropriate approving your application. Please note, without this letter from the supervisor/grant holder the application will not be considered.

Awards Committee

A subgroup of the BSN Committee chaired by the society's Grants Subcommittee Chair will act as the Travel Awards Committee.

Award criteria

Typically all applications will be funded where justified. Priority will be given to, in order, 1) presenters, 2) those without funds.

The committee reserve the right to decide on alternative funding criteria in exceptional circumstances.
